4. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

MEDICAL / DENTAL:

A candidate who fulfills the following stipulations shall be eligible to appear for the entrance test viz.,

Candidates should have passed II PUC /10 + 2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry Biology and English with 50% marks in aggregate in PCB (Those who have appeared and awaiting results of IInd PUC may also apply with the indication "Results are awaited" in the Application form)

The candidate should secure 50% of marks i.e. 90 marks out of total marks of 180 in UGCET 2010 to secure rank and eligible for counseling.

Any other Conditions as stipulated by Competent Authorities.

ENGINEERING:

Candidates should have passed II PUC / 10 + 2 or equivalent with Physics, Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with Chemistry / Bio Technology / Computer Science / Biology / Electronics as optional subjects with English as one of the languages of study and obtained an aggregate of minimum 45% in the optional subjects. (Those who have appeared and awaiting results of IInd PUC may also apply with the indication "Results are awaited" in the Application form).

Any other Conditions as stipulated by Competent Authorities.

The Entrance Test will be conducted on 30th May 2010.

8. HALL TICKET / ADMISSION TICKET:

Candidates should download the Admission Tickets by entering his / her name as user name and date of birth as password for example: if the candidate's name is Ashwin Kumar J and his date of birth is 17/03/1990, his user name is ashwinkumarj and password 17031990 from the association's website and produce it as the time of Entrance Test. The downloading of ADMISSION TICKET would be allowed from 22nd May, 2010 onwards from the website of the Association.

NOTE: Username should be typed in small letters only. Username should be typed as filled in application form with out any space in between.

9. ENTRANCE TEST DETAILS:

The test is for Maximum marks of 60 in each subject. The question papers of the UG CET 2010 will be mostly based on the First and Second PUC syllabi prescribed by the Department of Pre-University Education of Karnataka State. Each question paper will be Multiple Choice type. The candidates have to mark the correct answers on the OMR Answer sheets using BLUE OR BLACK BALL POINT PEN ONLY. THERE WILL BE NO NEGATIVE MARKING IN RESPECT OF WRONG ANSWERS BUT MARKS WILL NOT BE AWARDED IN RESPECT OF THE MULTIPLE ANSWERS MADE BY CANDIDATES ON THE OMR ANSWER SHEETS. The candidates are allowed to carry home the replica of the OMR Answer paper.

10. ANSWER KEYS:

The ANSWER KEYS will be uploaded on 30th May 2010. The objections, if any, should be sent by POST ONLY addressed to Chief Examiner along with a DD of Rs.100 per Question drawn in favour of KRLMPCA payable at Bangalore on or before 5.00 pm of 3rd June, 2010 in respect of any published answer key along with all the supporting documents. * Objections received by the Chief Examiner will be placed before the Expert Committee, whose decision will be final in this regard. AMOUNT RECEIVED IN RESPECT OF CHALLENGING OF KEY ANSWERS IS NOT REFUNDABLE.

* NO OBJECTIONS WILL BE ENTERTAINED AFTER THE DEADLINE INDICATED ABOVE

11. ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:

Basis for Admission

Allotment of seats will be on the basis of merit determined by ranking secured in UG CET 2010 conducted by the Association. Entrance Test will be for a maximum of 180 marks and for duration of 180 minutes. The Entrance Test will be conducted in English. Questions will be multiple choice types, each having four alternatives. Answer sheet is of OPTICAL MARK READER (OMR) type with carbonless copy. 50% of marks in the KRLMPCA UG CET 2010 **is a must for eligibility of admission** to Graduate Courses. Each question carries one mark. Correct answer will be awarded one mark. No mark/s will be awarded for multiple marking. No negative valuation. Key Answers of test will be notified on the website on the evening of Sunday the 30th May, 2010. Objections, if any, may be sent to the Association Office addressed to **“The Chief Examiner”** by post only, with a DD of Rs.100/- for each question. THIS AMOUNT IS NOT REFUNDABLE. No communication would be entertained in person by KRLMPCA after the last date as indicated. Rankings will not be awarded for those candidates who secure less than 50% of marks in the UG CET 2010. Candidates securing 50% of the marks and above in the UG CET will be ranked according to the marks secured by them in the UG CET 2010. No marks would be awarded for counseling. **Detailed instructions relating to centralized counseling will be put on the website at a later date.** KRLMPCA advises all the candidates to visit regularly the Association’s website for relevant information.

On the date of counseling, candidates who select seat will be issued provisional allotment orders. Candidates who are issued such provisional allotment orders should report at the college allotted along with original marks cards and certificates within 3 days from the date of allotment letter or **within the last date stipulated by the University for admission which ever is earlier.** Admission will be complete only when the candidate presents himself with the original marks cards and certificates at the allotted college and pays the fees in full.

12. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

- The candidates should fill all the columns provided in the application form. No alteration/addition Would be allowed when once it is received in the Association office.
- Downloaded Applications should accompany with a DD of Rs.1000.00 drawn in favour of KRLMPCA payable at Bangalore.
- All the filled applications should be sent by Speed post / Private Courier to the address mentioned below ONLY. No Application would be received in person.
