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ADMISSIONS

Admission to any course offered by Nitte University is through an Entrance Test (ET) conducted by it, fulfilling the requirements of UGC and statutory bodies such as MCI, DCI, INC, PCI and AICTE. Entrance Tests are designated as NUPGET and NUUGET for Post-graduate and Under-graduate courses respectively and the designations will also have the year of conducting the test for selecting the candidates for admission in that year. Entrance Test will be conducted at several centers (notified every year) spread over India. The Entrance Test will have Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs), each carrying one mark for the correct answer. Negative mark of half will be awarded for wrong answers only in the case of Post Graduate courses. Unanswered questions will not affect the marks scored. The number of questions will be 200 to be answered in 3 hours in the case of all PG courses and 180 questions for MBBS and BDS. All other courses will have 100 questions to be answered in 90 minutes. There will be 4 versions [A,B,C & D] of question papers containing the same questions but in different sequences. The response sheet is OMR and candidates will have to darken the appropriate circle with a black or blue ball-pen. The response sheet will have candidates signature, Test Admission Ticket (TAT) Number, Invigilator's signature and a Serial Number to ensure transparency. All these will be recorded along with question paper version code in the attendance sheets for candidates for that centre. Appearing for Entrance Test will not automatically assure a seat. Candidate should meet the eligibility criteria with respect to both qualifying exam as well as entrance test score.

On submitting the application for Entrance Test a Hall ticket (Test Admission Ticket, TAT) will be issued to the candidate with TAT Number and Centre name. It carries candidate's signature, photo and address, Signature of Registrar (Eval) and his seal.

Candidates can download applications for Entrance Test, Hall Tickets, Key to Answers, Rank position etc from the website www.nitteuniversity.ac.in.

Based on Entrance Test score for each course, a merit list will be prepared. Counselling of the candidates for the seats available with the University will be done as per the merit under Management category list. The second round of counselling will be done if vacancies arise with due notification.
